

# Ensemble Options

## Casting ages as follows:

*General Ensemble:* Middle school age to mature (12 and up)

*Youth Ensemble:* a pair consisting of a youth (ages 8-11) and an adult (18+) responsible for the minor. The pair will appear on stage together in several production numbers.

->Actors under 18: Must have a parent present at the audition venue. Parents will be asked into the audition space to cover key production related information and then be asked to leave so the actor can complete the audition.

The cast for this production will be supported by an ENSEMBLE of community members.

Those performing will either be:

An actor (middle school age to mature)

OR

A pair made up of a minor (aged 8-11) and an adult responsible for the minor.

Certain Youth ENSEMBLE roles will be utilized in various scenes but do NOT necessarily need to sing or follow specific choreography!

The intent is to allow families to participate in this production without having a full rehearsal schedule or the pressure of memorizing lines, etc...

However, if an older participant of the pair (aged 15+) is interested in a speaking/singing role, that may be able to be accommodated – review the Character List and indicate your interest on your Audition Form.

We would like to cast enough people so we may even be able to offer the Youth ENSEMBLE members without speaking roles a flexible performance schedule. This will be discussed at your audition.

We're looking forward to working with you to help us create a cast of fun, quirky, and well-crafted ENSEMBLE characters!

- General Information
  - ENSEMBLE members may be responsible for sourcing their own show appropriate wardrobe/costume. Details can be discussed at auditions and, if cast, with the Director during one-on-one meetings.
  - All ENSEMBLE auditions with a minor are to be done in pairs. If a family would like to audition together, there must be a parent/guardian with each child.
  - Official casting may be dependent on an approved background check.
